- (1)Paper submitters: The <u>thesis proposal</u> and <u>registration form</u> should be emailed to <u>wclc8@ms79.hinet.net</u> or wclacec@gmail.com before <u>July 30, 2014.</u> (Please download the registration form from the following web address: <u>www.wcla.org.tw</u>)
 - a. The submitted manuscript should not be presented before.
 - b. Each thesis proposal should be typed in Chinese and English within the range of 2,000~3,000 words in Word and PDF format.
 - c. Each submission must contain the following elements: abstract, thesis topic, references, research methods, <u>main arguments</u>, <u>original perspectives</u> and three to five keywords. The submission will be included in the pre-conference symposium once being accepted.
 - d. The conference committee will appoint distinguished experts to review the submitted thesis proposals anonymously. Authors will be notified of the result by September 30, 2014.
 - e. Once a thesis proposal is accepted, the author needs to submit the full-text paper to wclc8@ms79.hinet.net before October 30, 2014. A conference CD will be made. Authors are encouraged to submit their full papers to *Journal of Chinese Language Teaching*, an international journal published by World Chinese Language Association. (*JCLT* is on the list of TSSCI and THCI Core coded by Ministry of Science and Technology.)
- (2) Non-submitters: The registration form should be emailed to the WCLA before <u>September 15, 2014</u>.
- 6. Registration fee: NT\$3,000 per person (NT \$ 2,000 member of WCLA)
- 7. Conference languages: Chinese or English
