

Application Package

This application package shall be used and applied to the Taiwan Foreign English Teacher Program (TFETP) Application ONLY.

• **Deadline:** The Fall 2022 recruitment will begin from January 1st, 2022 on a rolling basis.

• Requirements:

All applicants must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the application:

- 1. native speaker from United States, Canada, England, New Zealand, Australia, South Africa, Ireland, etc. (English Speaking Country),
- 2. obtained a bachelor's or higher degree from accredited college or university,
- 3. hold a state-issued teaching license or certificate,
- 4. The applicant should provide a criminal record certificate/police check issued after January 1, 2022 from relevant authorities in his or her home country or the country he or she currently resides in. The certificate must include the name of the applicant, the date of issuance, and state that the applicant has no criminal record.
- 5. commit to abide by the laws and regulations of Taiwan,
- 6. be competent in interpersonal and communication skills,
- 7. demonstrate an understanding of and respect for the local culture,
- 8. be able to teach in a school in a rural area.

Required Documents:

- 1. Passport
- 2. Degree/Diploma/Certificate
- 3. State-Issued Teaching License/Certificate
- 4. Statement of Purpose
- 5. Teaching Demonstration Video
- 6. 2 Recommendation Letters
- 7. A police check/clearance issued after January 1st, 2022.

8. Health Check Report

• The Applicants will be invited to Interview (by skype).

Note:

Accepted candidates will receive an offer via email on a rolling basis, **normally** within 2 months after the online interview. Accepted candidates must reply to the offer within 10 days (including holidays and weekends).

However, candidates with acceptance notices are <u>NOT</u> automatically issued the work permit and/or the Resident Visa.

For work permit application, please visit the Council of Labor Affairs, R.O.C. (Taiwan).

For Resident Visa application, please visit the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, R.O.C. (Taiwan).

Failure to obtain the work permit and the Resident Visa after receiving the program acceptance notice could still result in the disqualification of candidacy.
